<b>Merchandise</b>	goods that are bought and sold
Shoppers complain about poor quality merchandise and high prices	
<b>Franchise</b>	a right to sell a company's products using the company's name
A new franchise shop was opened in Ljubljana.	
<b>best-selling</b>	a product that is extremely popular and has sold in very large numbers
His books are all bestsellers	
<b>graduated</b>	Finish high school
I hope I will graduate	
<b>variety</b>	the characteristic of often changing and being different
The hammer can be used for a variety of things	
<b>measles</b>	an infectious disease that produces small, red spots all over the body
My brother has measles	
<b>orphan</b>	a child whose parents are dead
Wars are making orphans of many children.	
<b>settled</b>	when you have become familiar with it and are comfortable and happy there
After years of travelling around, She has now settled her life.	
<b>brief</b>	lasting only a short time
I had a brief look of him	
<b>longhand</b>	ordinary writing by hand
Longhand writing is becoming a not common skill	
<b>numerous</b>	very many
Computers were, once rare, but now they are numerous.	
<b>worldwide</b>	existing or happening in all parts of the world
Gangnam style song is known worldwide	
<b>amazing</b>	extremely surprising
It's amazing that now anyone can make money with internet	
<b>similar</b>	looking or being almost, but not exactly, the same
I have bought new power supply which looks very similar to my old one	
<b>popular</b>	liked, enjoyed, or supported by many people
Gangnam style is very popular song	
<b>accustomed</b>	familiar with something
She quickly became accustomed with new machine	
<b>common</b>	the same in a lot of places or for a lot of people
It's common to watch Dnevnik in Slovenia	
<b>sort-out</b>	when you put things in order
It takes me a lot of time to sort-out mess in my workshop	
<b>once and for all</b>	completely and in a way that will finally solve a problem
I am going to tidy my room once and for all	
<b>home grounds</b>	familiar surrounding
It's nice to be back on home grounds after traveling	
<b>respond</b>	to say or do something as a reaction to something that has been said or done
I called her, but she didn't respond	
<b>poverty</b>	the condition of being extremely poor
The mayor decided to reduce poverty in the city	
<b>snapped up</b>	to immediately offer someone a job or position because you want them very much
He was snapped up by Nasa	
<b>make their mark</b>	to make people notice
Pixar made their mark with very qualitative cartoons	
<b>home grown</b>	If someone or something is home grown, it belongs to your own country
In Slovenia there are several big home grown businesses

<b>recently</b>	not long ago
I recently ordered a power supply	
<b>heated rivalry</b>	situation in which people, businesses, etc. compete with each other for the same thing
In economic crises there is rivalry for every job.	
<b>prefer</b>	to like, choose, or want one thing rather than another
I prefer desktop computer over laptop	
<b>huge sums of money</b>	a large amount of money
Samsung paid huge sums of money to apple for patents	
<b>dominated</b>	to have control over a place or person
School dominates my daily schedule	
<b>countless</b>	very many, or too many to be counted
I have countless ideas for my future projects	
<b>waste ground</b>	an area of ground near a city that is not built on, used in any way
In the past people dumped a lot of trash in area of wasted ground	
<b>global passion</b>	an extreme interest of the whole world
water supply for everybody should be a global passion	
<b>suffer</b>	to experience physical or mental pain
He was suffering from a really bad disease	
<b>brought on</b>	to make something happen, usually something bad
The loud noise brought on another fight with my neighbour	
<b>associate</b>	to connect someone or something in your mind with someone or something else
Most people associate summer with vacation	
<b>traumatic</b>	If an experience is traumatic, it causes you severe emotional shock and upset
School brings traumatic experiences to some students	
<b>altogether</b>	completely
Altogether life is good in Slovenia	
<b>repulsed</b>	to refuse something or someone unwanted
I am repulsed by spiders	
<b>adaptations</b>	something produced to adjust to different conditions or uses, or to meet different situations
Building adaptation can be very expensive	
<b>overwhelming</b>	difficult to fight against
He felt an overwhelming desire to tell someone about what had happened	
<b>prosperous</b>	successful, usually by earning a lot of money
I am going to start a prosperous business	
<b>exhausting</b>	making you feel extremely tired
Today is really an exhausting day	
<b>a bold</b>	brave
He was a bold and fearless driver	
<b>threatened</b>	to tell someone that you will kill or hurt them or cause problems
He threatened her with a gun	
<b>daring</b>	brave and taking risks
I performed a daring jump	
<b>inspiring</b>	encouraging, or making you feel you want to do something
I was inspired by tiny houses on wheels	
<b>frequently</b>	often
I see my grandma frequently	
<b>huge</b>	extremely large in size or amount

to ferry	to transport people or goods in a vehicle, especially regularly and often
<b>approached</b>	to come near to something or someone in space, time, quality, or amount
Yesterday I saw how the train was approaching us	
<b>struggled on</b>	to continue dealing with a difficult situation - to continue doing something difficult
I was struggling with steering system for my pedal car	
<b>perished</b>	to die
My dog perished	
<b>failed</b>	having not succeeded
I have one failed project behind	
<b>ambitious</b>	having a strong wish to be successful, powerful, or rich
He's very ambitious for his daughter	
<b>illiterate</b>	unable to read and write
There is a lot of illiterate people	
<b>established</b>	to start a company or organization that will continue for a long time
The company was established last week	
<b>remote</b>	far away in distance or time, or not closely related
He lives on a remote location	
<b>remarkable</b>	unusual or special and therefore surprising and worth mentioning
Nikola Tesla was a really remarkable person	
<b>disastrous</b>	extremely bad or unsuccessful
War can be disastrous for the country.	
<b>defeat</b>	to win against someone in a fight, war, or competition
Germany was defeated in WWII	
<b>certain</b>	having no doubt or knowing exactly that something is true, or known to be true
I am certain that I know who is going to win	
<b>bogs</b>	soft, wet ground, or an area of this
Bog can be dangerous	
<b>remained</b>	to stay in the same place or in the same condition
He remained calm	
<b>ascent</b>	the act of climbing or moving upwards
She made her first successful ascent to Everest	
<b>proclaimed</b>	to announce something publicly or officially, especially something positive
Cesar proclaimed his victory	
<b>radically</b>	fundamental
I radically changed the design of my boat

**Fractions:**  $1/2$  – a half,  $2/3$  – two thirds,  $3/4$  – three quarters,  $5/7$  – five sevenths

**Exponents:**  $9^2$  – nine squared,  $3^3$  – three cubed,  $2^7$  – two to the power of seven

**Root:**  $\sqrt{2}$  – square root of two,  $\sqrt[3]{8}$  – cubic root of eight

$a \times b = c \rightarrow$  a **multiplied** by b equals c,

$a / b = c \rightarrow$  a **divided** by b equals c

$a + b = c \rightarrow$  a **plus** b equals c,

$a - b = c \rightarrow$  a **minus** b equals c

$a > b \rightarrow$  a is **greater** than b

$a < b \rightarrow$  a is **less** than b

$a \geq b \rightarrow$  a is **greater or equals** to b

$a \leq b \rightarrow$  a is **less or equals** to b
