Yesterday, last week, 3 days ago, in 1980

+ I washed/drew. She washed/drew.

She washed/drew.
They washed/drew.
Did I wash/draw?
Did she wash/draw?
Did they wash/draw.
I didn't wash/draw.

She didn't wash/draw. They didn't wash/draw.

Past tense continous
All day yesterday, from
2 to 4, When..., While...

+ I was washing.
You were washing.
They were drawing.

? Was I washing. Were you washing. Was she washing.

- I was not washing. You were not washing. She wasn't washing.
