 She doesn't wash every day.
 Present continous tense

- Present continous tense
 Now, today, at the moment
 + I am washing. She is washing. They are washing.
 ? Am I washing.
 Is she washing. Are they washing.
 I am not washing. She isn't washing. They aren't washing.
