

What is AIDS?




- It's a sexual transmitted disease which has spread all over the world

38.6 million people living with HIV, 2005. Adult prevalence (proportion of 15-49 year-olds living with HIV/AIDS)



HIV stands for Human Immunodeficiency Virus and subsequently leads to AIDS.

How long does it take for H to become AIDS?



- The average time is 8 11 years
- Medical treatments can slow down the rate at which HIV weakens the immune s'

What happens with HIV inside our body?



- HIV is a retrovirus
- Activities that <u>allow</u> HIV transmission are:
- 1. unprotected sexual contacts
- 2. direct blood contact with the infect person
- 3. injection of drug n
- 4. blood transfusion
- 5. mother to a baby
