


Land and climate

Air temperatures fall below –
80°C in winter and rise only to
-30°C in summer;

Precipitation: mainly as snow or ice, with occasional rain;

Antarctica holds 70% of the Earth's freshwater, and 90% of Earth's ice.

- F Jagged coastline;

- The highest point:Vinson Massif -4,892 m;
