a) Present—> "must"


I must clean my room before I go out. = I have to clean my room before I go out.

I had to clean my room before I went out.


c) Future[] "will have to"


I will have to clean my room before going out.

TO EXPRESS CERTAINTY

a) Present (must+ inf.)

I am sure he is a doctor 🛛 He must be a doctor.

 b) At the moment of speaking (must+ be+ ing)

I am certain they are having a party. [] They must be having a party.

c) Past (must+ have+ past. Part.)

I am positive he moved to Celje. [] He must have moved to Celje.
