## The day of the eruption

It all spreaded over Pompeii and then air was full of ash. It all filled the streets and the whole city. Few escaped, but most of them didn't have that luck. The people and the buildings of Pompeii were covered in up to twelve layers of ash, which rained down for about 6 hours.

## Finding the lost city

- City was found at least one hundred years ago, when a local farmer hit something with a plow. Then they orderd to dig and to find treasure under the ground.
  So they found Pompeii again.
- People buried in ash appear to be wearing warmer clothing than the light summer clothes that would be expected in August. So far there is no definitive theory as to why there should be such an apparent discrepancy.
