She is the queen of the United Kingdom.

The elder daughter of King George VI and Queen Elizabeth, she was born on April 21, 1926 in London.

Five weeks after her birth she was christened in the chapel of Buckingham Palace and was given the names Elizabeth Alexandra Mary.

In 1930, Princess Elizabeth gained a sister, with the birth of Princess Margaret Rose. The family of four was very close.

Princess Elizabeth's quiet family life came to an end in 1936, when her grandfather, King George V, died. His eldest son came to the throne as King Edward VIII, but, before the end of the year, King Edward had decided to give up the throne in order to marry the woman he loved, Mrs Wallis Simpson.

Upon his resignation, Princess Elizabeth's father acceded to the throne as King George VI.

Princess Elizabeth was now first in line to the throne, and a figure of even more intense public interest.

During an Official tour of Kenya in 1952 Princess Elizabeth was informed of the death of her father, and that she was now Queen Elizabeth II.

She immediately returned to England to take on her duties and to lead the nation in mourning the death of King George VI.



Her coronation was in June , 1953.
