SLOVENIA

First, I am going to describe some general things.

- It covers the area of 20.000 square kilometers.
- It lies between four countries:
 - 1. (west) Italy,
 - 2. (north-east) Hungary,
 - 3. (south) Croatia and
 - 4. (north) Austria.
- The population is about 2,000,000.
- The state language is Slovenian.
- The anthem of Sloveina is Zdravljica. The lyric was written by a well known poet France Prešeren (1800-1848). He wrote only one poetry book called Poezije. We can find his portrait on 2€ coin.
- The capital of Slovenia is Ljubljana. It is largest city in Slovenia and is also beautiful.
- The city core Tromostovje was built by a very famous architect Jože Plečnik. Tromostovje are three bridges that are situated in the middle of Ljubljana, and passes the river Ljubljanica, which flows through this city.
- **Maribor** is the second largest city of Slovenia. It lies on the river Drava. Lent is the oldest part of Maribor.
- **Ptuj** is the oldest town of Slovenia. It is situated in Podravje, northeastern Slovenia. Important for history of Ptuj is Ptuj castle.
- The longest river of Slovenia is Sava. The Sava Bohinjka is a beautiful alpine river which pours out of the Lake Bohinj.
 Lake Bohinj is the largest natural lake of Slovenia.

- We are very proud on Karst, becouse of caves, underground rivers and lakes. The two of most visited caves are Postojna cave and Škocijanske caves. Trougt the Postojna cave you can take the ride with small trains. There you can see an animal – a human fish who live just in this cave.
- About sixty percent of the country's surface is covered by woods.
- The higest mountain in Slovenia is Triglav. It is 2864m high.
- There is Aljažev stolp at the top of the Triglav, which was built by a priest Jakob Aljaž, who bought a part of the mountain to pervert foreigners to take over Triglav.
- Lake Bled is the most beautiful lake. Not beacuse of its size, but because there is an island in the middle of it. There is a very old church on it.
- We also have 46 km long coast line in Slovenia. There are two big tourist cities:
- Koper (there is the biggest slovenian port),
- Portorož (is one of the country's largest tourist areas).
