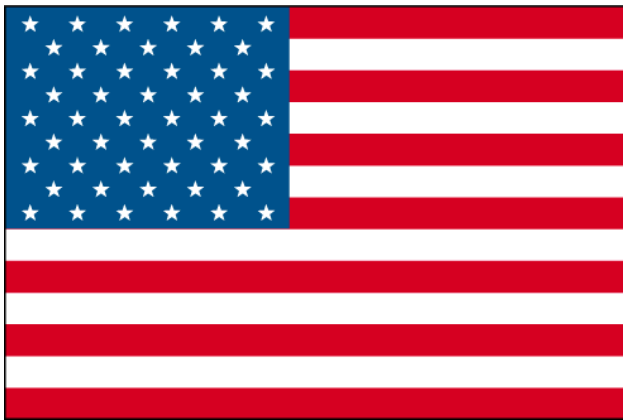


USA

HISTORY

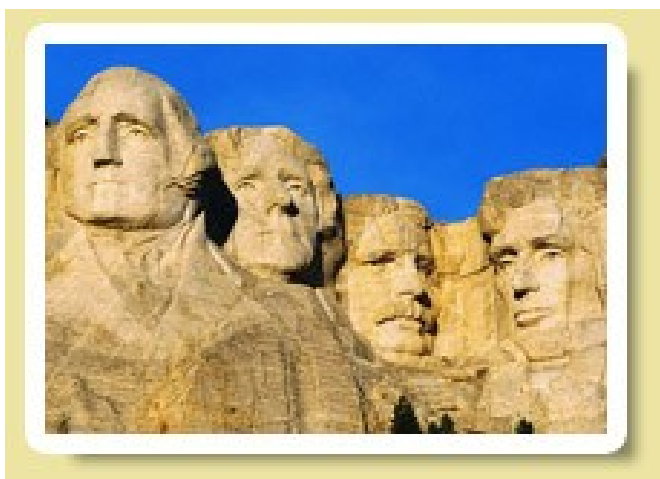

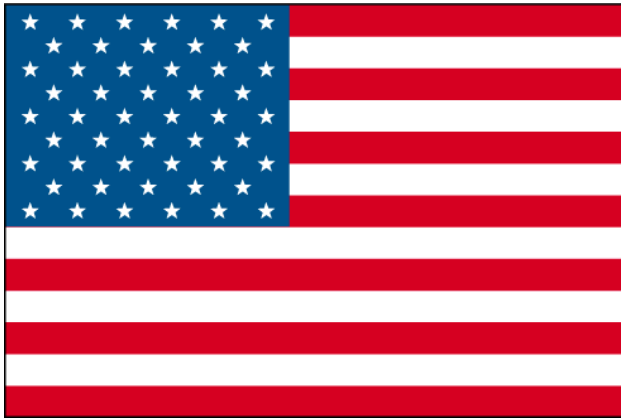
