3.) IF THE ADJECTIVE ENDS IN -A, IT CHANGES INTO -ILY happy → happily easy → easily

4.) IF THE ADJECTIVE ENDS IN -IC WE ADD - ALLY

romantic → romantically dromatic → dromatically

5.) IRREGULAR FORMS

 $good \rightarrow well$  fast  $\rightarrow$  fast

hard → hard

hardly → komaj da (He could hardly speak)
