whistle [wisł] intransitive verb (za)žvižgati, požvižgavati;

eat [i:t] transitive verb jesti, pojesti,
mutter [mʌ́tə] noun mrmranje, momljanje, godrnjanje;
talk [t*:k] intransitive verb pogovarjati se, govoriti
taste [téist] transitive verb (p)okusiti, (p)okušati
whisper [wíspə] intransitive verb šepetati, šepniti, zašepetati,
bite [bait] transitive verb gristi, odgristi
chew [čú:] transitive verb & intransitive verb žvečiti, prežvekovati;
lick [lik] transitive verb lizati, polizati, oblizati;

mouth/nose:

breathe [bri:ð] intransitive verb dihati, vdihavati;

nose:

smell [smel] transitive verb & intransitive verb (za)duhati, poduhati (at kaj), zavohati; vonjati,
sniff [snif] noun (po)vohanje, (po)duhanje; hlipanje, smrkanje,

shoulders:

shrug [šrʌg] noun skomizg (z rameni);

BODY IDIOMS:

Get the cold shoulder (from someone) be ignored, be rejected

Goose bumps the bumpy skin (like a goose) that one gets because of excitement or fear

A pain in the neck an annoying or bothersome person or event

You scratch my back and I'll scratch yours you do a favour for me and I'll do a favour for you

Skin-deep only on the surface, not having any deep or honest meaning

Stab (someone's) in the back betray someone

Take (someone's) breath away overwhelm someone with beauty or grandeur, cause someone to be out of breath

Thick-skinned insensitive, not easily upset or hurt

Thin-skinned easily upset or hurt, very sensitive

Put your finger on something to discover the exact reason why a solution is the way it is, especially when something is wrong

betray [bitréi] transitive verb izdati, izneveriti se; zapeljati
overwhelm [ouvə(h)wélm] transitive verb (zlasti figuratively) zdrobiti, uničiti, premagati;
grandeur [grć́ndžə, grć́ndjə, grć́ndjuə] noun veličina, veličastnost; imenitnost
insensitive [insénsitiv] adjective (~ly adverb) neobčutljiv, brezčuten, nedražljiv (to za)
sensitive [sénsitiv] adjective zelo občutljiv, preobčutljiv, senzitiven;
exact [igzć́kt] adjective (~ly adverb) točen, natančen; vesten;
