WHEN

Common time expressions:
 tomorrow, next (week, month, year), in 2055, etc. In four years` time

We use the Future Simple (`will`):

1 to express neutral facts

2 to express predictions, expectations, and hopes.

3 to express spontaneous decisions

1 Nepristransko stališče

- **He `ll be fourteen years old in**

September

- I'll go to bed at 9 pm

2 Napovedi, pričakovanja in upe:

- I think it'll rain tomorrow
We won't win the football match

3 Spontane (samodejne) odločitve

- I'll have fish and chips

Common time expressions: tonight,
This evening, at the weekaend, tomorrow
Morning, etc

1 to express our intentions and plans

2 to express predictions

Prihodnjik z **going to** ima naslednje pomene:

1 Z njim izražamo svoje namere in načrte:

- **I`ve won a lot of money. I`m going to buy a House**
- **At the weekend we are going to travel to Scotland**

2 Uporabimo ga, če na podlagi znamenj in okoliščin lahko sklepamo, da se bo nekaj zgodilo:

- **Look at those black clouds! It`s going to rain**
- **Bob is writing a mathes test, but he hasn`t worked hard for it. – He`s going to get a bed mark**
