

IDIOMS:

to drop a line	to get back in touch with sb-by writing
to kick the habit	to stop doing sth harmful (smoking, ...)
to think the world of someone	to have a very good opinion of sb/sth
to kiss something goodbye	to accept that you will lose sth
to blow your own trumpet	to praise your own abilities, achievements
to hit the roof	suddenly become very angry
to hold your breath	to be anxious while waiting for sth you are worried about

Animal idioms:

to smell a rat	to suspect that sth is wrong
to set the cat among the pigeons	to do sth that is likely to cause trouble
to behave like a bull in a china shop	to be clumsy
to sort out sheep from the goats	to sort out good people from bad
to make an ass of yourself	to be embarrass
to talk until the cows come home	for a very long time (late in night)
to be gentle as a lamb	very gentle
to be unable to say boo to a goose	to be shy
to have a stag party / (to have a hen party for women)	men having party with friends, before getting married
to be like water off a duck's back	very easily, without any problems/fears

Other idioms:

to get sth off your chest	to talk about sth that has been worrying, so that you feel less anxious
to bite sb's head off	to shout at sb, especially without reason
to poke/stick your nose in	to try to become involved in sth that does not concern you, to be curious
to be up to your eyes in sth (in work)	to have a lot of sth to deal with
to get cold feet	suddenly become nervous about doing sth (stisniti rep med noge)
to break sb's heart	to make sb feel very unhappy
to keep an eye on sb	to take care of sb/sth, make sure they are safe, not harmed
to twist sb's arm	to persuade or force sb to do sth
to fell head over heels (in love)	loving sb very much

(to whisper) behind sb's back	without sb's knowledge or permission
to make up your mind	to decide for sth
