- **a traffic warden** = *prometnik*, *redar* = official who enforces parking regulations
- **a dustman** = *smetar* = *somebody* who works as a street cleaner or refuse collector
- **a window dresser** = *aranžer izložbenega okna* = somebody who a displays of merchandise for sale in a store window
- **an estate agent** = *nepremičninski agent* = somebody who buys and sells property
- **a secretary, a typist** = *tajnik* = somebody who does general clerical and administrative work such as word-processing, filing, and arranging appointments for an individual or an organization
- **an undertaker** = *podjetnik* = somebody who sets about something
- **a bricklayer** = *zidar* = somebody who builds with bricks
- **a civil servant** = *državni uradnik* = somebody who works in a state or federal government department
- **a vet** = *veterinary* = to subject somebody or something to a careful examination or scrutiny, especially when this involves determining suitability for something
- **a doctor** = *doctor* = somebody qualified and licensed to give people medical treatment
- **a newsagent** = *prodajalec časopisov* = somebody who keeps a store or stall selling mainly newspapers, magazines, and often paperback books and candy
- **a chef** = *glavni kuhar* = a professional cook, especially the principal cook in a hotel or restaurant
- **an architect, an interior decorator** = *arhitekt* = somebody whose job is to design buildings and advise on their construction
- a librarian = knjižničar = somebody who works in or is in charge of a library
- **a fishmonger** = *trgovec z ribami* = somebody who sells fish to eat
- **a miner** = *rudar* = somebody who works in a mine digging for minerals, especially coal
- **a curator** = *upravitelj* (*knjižnice*) = the administrative head of a museum, gallery, or other collection
- **an editor** = *založnik* = somebody who is in overall charge of the publication of a book, newspaper, or magazine
- **a reporter** = *poročevalec* = somebody whose job is to find out facts and use the print or broadcast media to tell people about them
- **a docker** = *delavec v pristanišču* = somebody whose job is to load and unload cargo vessels in a port
- **a shop assistant** = *prodajalec* = somebody who is employed to assist and sell goods to customers in a retail store
- **a teacher** = *učitelj* = somebody who teaches, especially as a profession
- **a chiropodist** = *manikerka* = the branch of medicine concerned with the treatment and care of the feet
- **a florist** = *cvetličar* = somebody who owns or works in a shop that sells flowers and ornamental plants
- **a cashier, an accountant** = *blagajnik* = somebody who deals directly with customers and handles routine account transactions
- **a farmer** = *kmet* = somebody who owns or operates a farm

- **a mechanic** = *mehanik* = a skilled worker who is employed to repair or operate machinery or engines
- **a hairdresser** = *frizer* = somebody who cuts, styles, colors, or curls hair as a profession
- **an office worker** = *delayec v pisarna* = somebody who works in office
- **a pilot** = *pilot* = somebody who is qualified to fly an aircraft or spacecraft
- **a vicar** = *duhovnik* = a priest in the Anglican Church who is in charge of a parish and receives a salary but not the tithes
- **a musician** = *glasbenik* = somebody who plays, performs, conducts, or composes music, either as a hobby or a profession
- **a businessman** = *poslovnež* = a man who works in business, especially at a senior level
- **a manager** = *upravitelj* = somebody who is responsible for directing and controlling the work and personnel of a business, or of a particular department within a business
- **a porter** = $nosa\check{c}$ = somebody who is employed to carry people's luggage, for example, at an airport, railroad station, or in a hotel
- **a waiter** / **a waitress** = *natakar* / *natakarica* = somebody employed to bring food and drink to people, usually in a restaurant
- **a plumber** = *instalater vodovodnih*, *plinskih cevi* = somebody who installs and repairs pipes and fixtures, especially for water, drainage, or heating systems in a building
- **an electrician** = *elektrikar* = somebody licensed to install, maintain, repair, or approve electrical wiring or electrical goods
- **a carpenter** = *tesar* = somebody who builds and repairs wooden structures, for example, houses and boats, or the wooden parts of them
- **a nurse** = *bolničarka* = somebody trained to look after sick and injured people, especially somebody who works in a hospital or clinic, administering the care and treatment that a doctor prescribes
- **an actor** / **an actress** = *igralec* / *igralka* = somebody who acts in plays, movies, or television
- **a shoemaker** = *čevljar* = somebody who makes or repairs boots or shoes
- **a chimney sweep(-er)** = *dimnikar* = somebody whose job is removing soot from chimneys
- **a stewardess** / **a steward** = *stevardesa* = a woman who attends to the passengers on an aircraft
- **an artist** = *umetnik* = somebody who creates art, especially paintings, drawings, or sculptures
- **a cleaner** = *čistilec* = somebody whose job is to clean the interior of a building
- **a writer** = *pisec* = somebody who writes books or articles as a profession
