OFFER =PONUDBA	CAN COULD SHALL WILL WOULD LIKE	Can we do anything for you?(informal) I could help you wash the dishes. Shall I help you?(informal) I will help you.(informal) Would you like a glass of water?
SUGGESTION =PREDLOG	SHALL CAN COULD	Shall we go? We can go now if you like. We could leave if you want.
PROHIBITION =PREPOVED	CAN'T MUSTN'T NOT BE ALLOWED TO MAY NOT	You can't play here.(You arent allowed to play...) You mustn't smoke here. It isnt allowed to park here. You may not play here.(formal)
OBLIGATION =OBVEZA	MUST HAVE TO	I must eat healthy food.(strong obligation;i say so.) I have to eat healthy food.(strong obligation;the doctor says so.)
LACK OF OBLIGATION =OBVEZE NI	NOT HAVE TO	Students don't have to wear school uniforms in Slovenia. (It is not necessary)
ADVICE =NASVET	SHOULD OUGHT TO SHALL HAD BETTER	You should drink more water.(genera advice) You ought to be more careful when using facebook.(more formal) Shall I buy that car?(asking for advice) You'd better not tell anybody your password.
ABILITY =ZMOŽNOST	CAN BE ABLE TO	He can read Latin. He is able to climb high trees.
NECESSITY =NUJA,POTREBA	MUST HAVE TO NEED	We must buy a new car.(We say so.) She has to put some petrol in the car. My car needs repairin.(It's necessary.)
PERMISSION =DOVOLJENJE	CAN COULD MAY BE ALLOWED TO	You can/cant have my bicycle.(informal) Could I use my computer?(more polite) You may use my computer.(formal) I was allowed to drive my father's car.
