Modal verbs of deduction

→ Certainity / gotovost

I'm sure ... I'm certain ... I'm convinced ...

There is no doubt ... I bet ...

MUST, CAN'T

→ Possibility / verjetnost

MAY, COULD → domnevamo, da nekaj je, da se nekaj dogaja (pri could malo manj) MIGHT → domnevamo, a hkrati tudi dvomimo

It's possible ...Maybe ...Perhaps ...I doubt ...I'm not certain ...I might not ...

- Present Simple & Future Simple

modalni glagol + nedoločnik

Maybe we will apply for a scholarship. \rightarrow We might apply for a scholarship. Shem ust have a brother.

- Present Continuous

modalni glagol + be + ing

She must be talking now.

- Past Simple & Present Perfect Simple

modalni glagol + have + 3. glagolska oblika

He can't have obeyed his father. They might have sent thih present.

- Past Continuous & Present Perfect Continuous

modalni glagol + have been + -ing

I'm sure she was crying. → She must have been crying. Perhaps you have been exaggerating. → You might have been exaggerating.

- <u>Passive</u> → Present Simple & Future simple

modalni glagol + be + 3. glagolska oblika

I'm sure he is often asked that question. → He must often be asked that question.

→ Past Simple & Present Perfect Simple

modalni glagol + have + been + 3. glagolska oblika

I doubt he was taken to hospital. \rightarrow He might not have been taken to hospital.
