Pres.Simple T.	A mech. repairs a car	A car <u>is repaired</u> by mechanic
Pres. Simp. Cont.	A mech. is repairing a car	A car <u>is being repaired</u> by mechanic
Pres. Perf. Sim. T.	A mech. has repaired a car	A car <u>has been repaired</u> by mechanic
Pres. Perf. Cont.	A mech. has been repairing a car	A car /
Past Simp. Tense	A mech. repaired a car	A car <u>was repaired</u> by mechanic
Past Tense Contin.	A mech. was repairing a car	A car <u>was being repaired</u> by mech.
Past Perf. Simple	A mech. had repaired a car	A car <u>had been repaired</u> by mechanic
Past Perf. Contin.	A mech. had been repairing a car	A car /
Will Future Simple	A mech. will repair a car	A car <u>will be repaired</u> by mechanic
Will Futur. Contin.	A mech. will be repairing a car	A car /
»going to« Future	A mech. is going to repair a car	A car <u>is going to be repaired</u> by mech
Future Perfect T.	A mech. will have repaired a car	A car <u>will have been repaired</u> by mec
Future Perf. Contin	A mech. will have been repairing a car	A car /

Passive of if clauses:

Pres. Conditional	A mech. would repair a car	A car <u>would be repaired</u> by mechanic
Past Conditional	A mech. would have repaired a car	A car <u>would have been repaired</u> by m
Must	A mech. must repair a car	A car <u>must be repaired</u> by mechanic
Have to	A mech. has to repair a car	A car <u>has to be repaired</u> by mechanic
Can	A mech.can repair a car	A car <u>can be repaired</u> by mechanic
