#### 1. Yes/No questions:

Have you watered the flowers jet? - Yes. Are you learning maths every day? - No.

2. **WH - questions**: who, what, why, where, ... how

Who are you? Why aren't you at school? What have you done? How old are you?

# Types of QUESTIONS:

#### **DIRECT:**

- Are you a student?
- What's your name?
- When did she do it?

#### INDIRECT:

- She wanted to know if I a student am?
- He was wondering what my name is?
- I don't know when she didi it?

### 3. Question tags/Tag guestions:

He made a mistake, didn't he?

They haven't done it, have they?

• I am late, <u>aren't I</u>? (I am not late, am

- Let's go home, shall we?
- Speak louder, will you.
- Don't smoke, will you.

### 4. Short questions:

She has just lost her job. - <u>Has she</u>? He wrote an interesting article? - <u>Did he</u>? I am a teacher. - <u>Are you</u>?

### 6. Questions wih the preposition at the end:

He died of cancer. - What did he die of?
She is very proun of her career. - What is she proud of?
This pen belongs to her. - Who does this pen belong to?
They have just sent for the doctor? - Who have they just sent for?

# 7. Short questions with the preposition at the end:

He died. - <u>What of</u>?
She is worried? - <u>What about</u>?
They found him guilty? - <u>What of</u>?
